

HICKORY TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONTHLY MEETING
October 2, 2017

The supervisors of Hickory Township met at the township building for their regular monthly meeting. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisors present were Kathy Abranovich, Bill Dean and Jon Sweet. Also in attendance were Carol Kordish, Chief Mike Vitale, Mike Hall, Tom McCormick, Jodi Johnson and Mariann Manzo.

Minutes from September meeting were accepted as read without additions or corrections. A motion was made by Bill, 2nd by Jon to pay current bills, payroll and all incoming regular bills, motion carried. The police report was given for the month of September by Chief Vitale: 203 Twp. hours, 72 School hours, 2038 miles, 154 gallons of gas, 58 incidents, 32 investigations and 26 traffic stops.

Public Comments: As per Kathy the minutes will now be posted on the township website. Mariann Manzo asked who cut the grass across from her house and who put the stone around the culvert. Bill responded. Jodi Johnson inquired about dump trucks driving and ruining Countyline Road. Kathy responded that a portion of that road has been bonded by the contractor.

Old Business: The ceiling grid has been installed and they are awaiting Houston Electric to install the light fixtures before ceiling tiles will be installed. Mike Hall installed the diffusers. Kathy will go ahead and order the carpet. DEP denied the Byler subdivision. Kathy checked into funding for Hartzell Road. We received (2) proposals, one from Taylor for approximately \$125,000. and one from Hanover for approximately \$139,000. Kathy will contact Taylor to begin with the permitting process. Kathy will again apply for funding through the county. She has been informed that they have approximately \$30,000. available. Taring and chipping is 100% complete and the mowing has been completed for this year. No other old business.

New Business: Motion made by Bill, 2nd by Jon to pass Resolution 8 of 2017 “County Aid Request”, motion carried. Motion made by Bill, 2nd by Jon to pass Ordinance 2 of 2017 “Amendment to Zoning Ordinance”, motion carried. Supervisors agreed to set trick or treat hours for Tuesday, October 31, 2017 from 5:30 pm to 7 pm and gave Mike Vitale permission to purchase candy not more than \$60. A letter was sent to Kreitzer’s regarding violation of township zoning ordinance. No other new business. Floor opened for additional comments.

A motion was made by Bill, 2nd by Jon to adjourn the meeting at 7:47 pm, motion carried.
